


# 2020 End-of-Support Milestone in Office 365

- Jan 14** • **O365 ProPlus support in Windows 7**  
Office 365 ProPlus will not support Windows 7 OS. Microsoft suggests using Windows 10.
  - Jan 15** • **TLS 1.0 and 1.1 in O365 GCC High and DoD**  
Client servers and browser servers that uses TLS 1.0/1.1 will experience connection issues in Office 365.
  - Jan 18** • **SharePoint Classic and Delve Blogs**  
SharePoint Classic and Delve blogs are way to retirement. You need to move your content to Modern Communication Site.
  - Feb** • **Unified Messaging in Exchange Online**  
Unified Messaging (UM) in Exchange Online is replaced by Cloud Voicemail and Auto-Attendant services.
  - Feb 8** • **Microsoft Invoicing**  
Microsoft Invoicing app will be retired and removed from the productivity.
  - Feb 28** • **SP Classic Popularity Reports**  
Microsoft is retiring classic usage and popularity reports for Classic sites, which includes reports for site collections, sites, document libraries, folders and individual items.
  - Mar 1** • **ZapEnabled Param in HostedContentFilterPolicy Cmdlet**  
Since ZapEnabled parameter is retiring, you need to update your scripts with new parameters.
  - Apr 1** • **Retiring Search-Mailbox Cmdlet**  
You can't use \*-MailboxSearch cmdlets to create In-Place eDiscovery and In-Place Holds.
  - May 31** • **Power BI Retiring TLS 1.0 and 1.1**  
Older versions of browsers and operating systems that only support TLS versions 1.0 and 1.1 will no longer be able to view Power BI data.
  - June 1** • **Office 365 Retiring TLS 1.0 and 1.1**  
All connections to Office 365 using the protocols TLS 1.0 and TLS 1.1 will not work.
  - June 30** • **Outlook Customer Manager**  
OCM won't be available after June 30.
  - July 1** • **Legacy eDiscovery Tools**  
Microsoft is retiring Advanced eDiscovery V1.0 and In-Place eDiscovery and Hold tool.
  - Oct 13** • **2013 Client Connectivity to O365**  
Office 2013 client's connections to commercial Office 365 services will not be supported.
  - Oct 13** • **Office 2016 for Mac**  
Office 2016 for Mac won't receive any security updates and bug fixes.
  - Oct 13** • **Basic Auth for Legacy Protocols**  
List of legacy protocols won't be able to connect to Exchange Online using basic Authentication.
